OBSERVATIONS FROM THE DECK BY PR. TOM GREVLOS (INTERIM SENIOR PASTOR)

"Therefore, since we are surrounded by so great a cloud of witnesses, let us also lay aside every weight and the sin that clings so closely, and let us run with perseverance the race that is set before us, looking to Jesus the pioneer and perfecter of our faith, who for the sake of the joy that was set before him endured the cross, disregarding its shame, and has taken his seat at the right hand of the throne of God." (Hebrews 12:1-2)

When I first arrived at Hope in June 2024, as a "green" Interim Pastor, I would occasionally use the language describing my role as a "Long-Term Substitute Teacher". As I grew into the position and responsibility, I did not find that to be an apt metaphor. What I came to recognize is that I was more of a "Guest Conductor".

What a joy and privilege it has been to be your Guest Conductor Interim Senior Pastor this last year-and-half. I am thankful to God for the experience of serving with you and I grateful to you all for your grace even when this Guest Conductor occasionally hit a wrong note. Sunday, November 16th, will be my last sermon in this role as I focus on the "Unshakeable Hope" that is ours in Jesus! What follows are a few observations of the Church and this faith community, Hope Lutheran Church. You have lived into your name beautifully. As I have said before publicly, when Jeanne and I look for a faith community we will look for a Hope Lutheran.

Observation #1 Hope's beautiful diversity!

Our unity in Christ should not be confused with uniformity of expressing that unity. In our attempt to stay in our comfort zone or try and reclaim the past, the temptation is to become tribal. The composition of Hope is a beautiful collage of colors, traditions, gender identities, political ideologies, experiences, demographics, and economics. When our agenda is "fixing our eyes on Jesus" our differences need not divide because we are united in the love of Jesus Christ. I urge you people of Hope Lutheran, do not become tribal but to "run the race".

OBSERVATIONS FROM THE DECK BY PR. TOM GREVLOS (INTERIM SENIOR PASTOR) CONTINUED...

Observation #2 Hope's beautiful possibilities!

It has been my joy and blessing to have visited many local churches in numerous countries. At Holy Spirit Lutheran in Nitra, Slovakia; Congregation Belen in Lima, Peru; churches in Port au Prince and Marigot, Haiti; Augustina Luterana in Guatemala, and a beautiful little church in Chamoio, Mozambique. What I believe both globally and locally, is that the local church is God's design for sharing the hope of Jesus!

Hope Lutheran is a critical anchor in people's lives right here in the Coachella Valley. Whether you live here all year round or seasonally, Hope is just scratching the surface of what the power of the Holy Spirit can do through you! Your financial commitment and openness to innovative ways to be the church in the time and place is critical for the vitality and relevancy of Hope! I urge you brothers and sisters in Christ, keep reflecting the light of Christ in this community.

Observation #3 Hope's beautiful spirit!

From day one I felt a genuine warmth and welcome at Hope. Creating such an environment has been and is evident in the Pastors and Church Staff but in your kindness and humor and willingness to learn new music, worship in new ways, and welcome new people. I no longer feel like a "Guest Conductor", just a "Conductor". Thank you. The environments we create matter. I urge you children of God at Hope to hoist your sails to catch the wind of the Spirit, not to stay in the harbor where it appears to be safe. May we all have the same mind of Christ where our attitude is one of joy and abundance, not scarcity and fear. It's a great day to be the church! Thank you Hope for being the church!







Delivering Apple Pie by Bill Reichert

Exciting news for Hope Book Club members!

Our November selection is "Delivering Apple Pie" by Bill Reichert and the author will be with us! It is an epic novel with a sweeping span and cinematic prose that delivers what modern fiction must: a cast of memorable characters, sharp dialogue along a quick witted, illuminated narrative. "Delivering Apple Pie" interweaves the lives of the characters between 1940 - 1963, from the war in the Pacific (World War II) to postwar suburbia and the baby boom.

Author Bill Reichert showcases and vividly describes the historical events and societal changes in a rapidly changing world. Women, in particular, are pulled from responsible wartime careers and shoehorned into more limited household roles. For many all-Americans the suburb is not exactly a perfect fit.






HOPE FOOD PANTRY

PRAYER SHAWL MINISTRY




Our prayer shawls were blessed on Sunday, October 12th and are ready to spread love.

STEPHEN MINISTRY




Your Hope Stephen Ministry team welcomes four new trained care givers: Molly Farrin, Jim Barger, Pat Leach and Gary Leach.


