
IN APPRECIATION - MARILYN DEVALON

When I think of Marilyn, I think all things Hope Lutheran Church! In so many ways, she has served our church since joining Hope in 1997. She soon joined the Alter Guild, Quilters, and Esther Circle. She worked on the Hardanger Communion Alter Cloth, which came to the attention of Pastor Carl. She offered it to him for Hope and that began a new tradition. She stitched a total of four during her Lutheran church affiliations, including 2 for Hope. Marilyn is also responsible for making most, if not all the Chrismos adorning our sanctuary Christmas tree. Her Lutheran church involvement goes back to 1960, for a total of 61 years.

It wasn't long after this that she approached Pastor Carl about creating an outreach service to other widows in the church. This service led to her becoming one of our first Stephen Leaders in 2003, continuing to direct and develop the successful program we have today.

Hope Lutheran Church is the official sponsor of the "Read with Me" volunteer program at Saul Martinez Elementary school in Mecca, and our activities are in full swing. A total of 37 volunteers have registered for the current school year. Seventeen of them are members of our church. We have a few volunteers doing their tutoring via remote zoom, but most of us are in the classroom one or two days a week. Some of our Canadian volunteers are still hoping to join us as travel becomes easier for them.

Since many of our volunteers have been with the program for several years, they are comfortable with the school and teachers, and can be active without further training. This has enabled us to spend more time on our needy family fund. Even though not the focus of "Read with Me", we find that problems at home affect our students' ability to learn, and we try to help. Unfortunately, we have received more requests for help with funeral expenses and living expenses when the breadwinner in the family dies. It's sad to see young kids be faced with such trauma.

Thank you for your participation and your donations. We are fortunate to have major donors who underwrite the administrative overhead of "Read with Me". That means all donations earmarked for the needy family fund, or for Saul Martinez Elementary School, will be used in total for these purposes. 



THE LANDING



From 7pm-9pm. Meeting in the parking lot until March.
