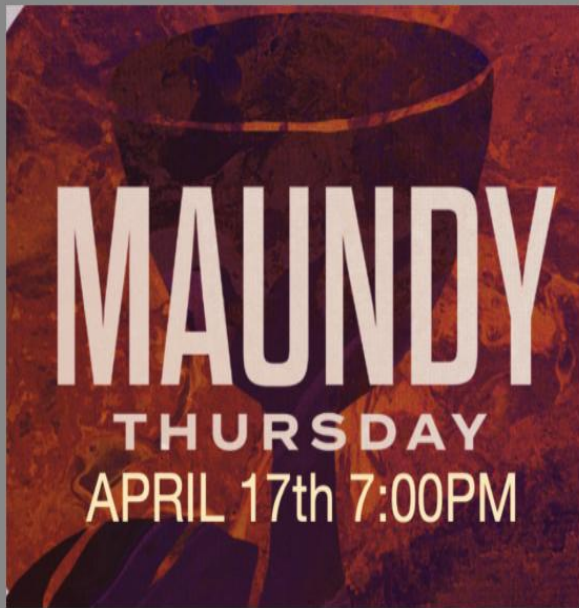

My personal favorite? Les Misérables!

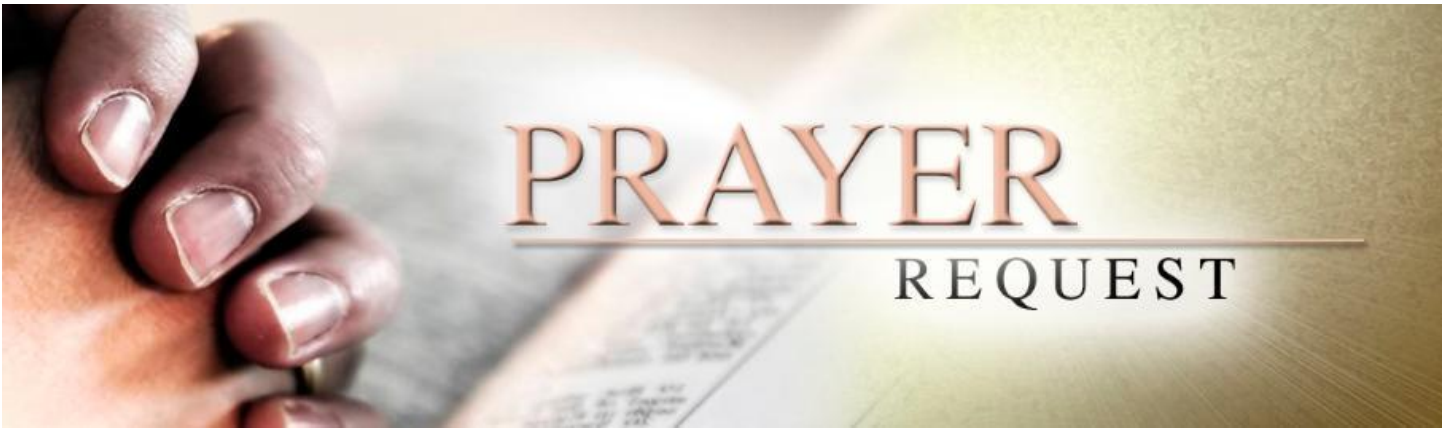

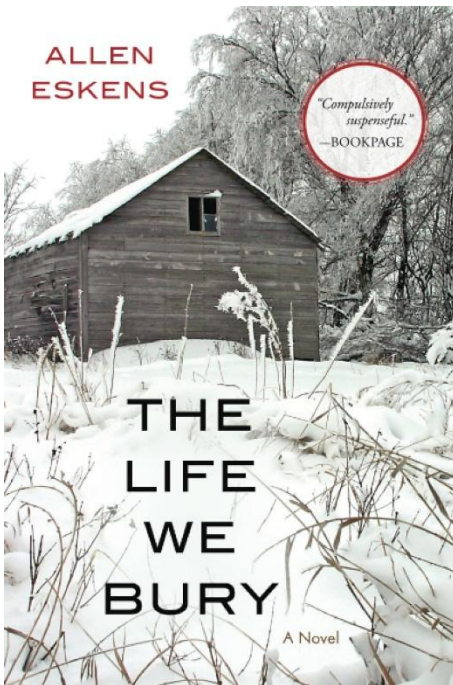
Hope Lutheran Food Pantry

T*he Life We Bury* tells the story of Joe Talbert, a junior at the University of Minnesota, who receives a class assignment to write a biography of someone who has lived an interesting life. At a nursing home he meets Carl Iverson, a man dying of cancer who has been medically paroled after spending thirty years in prison for the murder of a fourteen-year-old girl. Carl agrees to tell Joe his story, and Joe sets out to unravel the tapestry of the thirty-year-old murder.

The Life We Bury is full of tension, twists and turns, and has a powerful, climactic ending sure to gratify. But in the end, it is the bond between Joe and his brother Jeremy that gives this novel its big (albeit tormented) heart.

Burial within the church itself, or in an adjacent churchyard cemetery was once a common practice. Our Columbarium now provides parishioners a final resting place within church grounds, and offers a wonderful place to remember loved ones. Every Sunday family and friends of those interred take a moment to thank God for their loved ones with a brief prayer in the Memorial Garden. 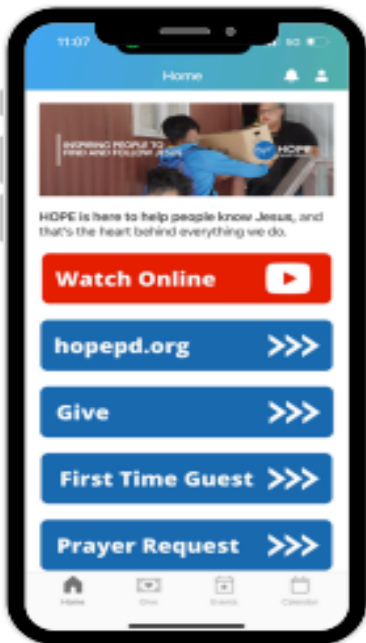


A "Lay Ministry" to those in need...
