What a beautiful and hopeful weekend we experienced at Hope.

This past Sunday, Pastor Tony Stiff preached at all three services in view of a call to become Hope's next Senior Pastor. Following each service, the congregation voted on extending a call...and I'm grateful to share that Pastor Tony received an overwhelmingly positive vote to become the next Senior Pastor of Hope Lutheran Church. The vote was only 2 votes shy of being unanimous!

There's a great deal of excitement around Hope right now...and understandably so.

Over the coming weeks, Pastor Tony and his family will begin preparing for a major transition. They'll be selling their home in Northern California, purchasing a home here in the desert, and making all the arrangements that come with relocating a family. As soon as we know the date of Pastor Tony's first Sunday with us, we'll let the congregation know immediately.

At this point, because of the many moving pieces involved with a significant transition like this, we anticipate his first Sunday will likely be around the beginning of August.

In the meantime...I simply want to say thank you!

Thank you for your faithfulness to Hope Lutheran Church over these last two plus years without a settled Senior Pastor. Thank you for continuing to worship, serve, give, pray, encourage one another, and believe in what God is doing through this church family.

It will be my joy to continue serving this amazing congregation until Pastor Tony officially begins his ministry among us.

God has been faithful every step of the way and I'm confident incredible days are ahead for Hope. How can I be confident? Because of how the Apostle Paul concludes Chapter 3 in his letter to the Ephesians: Now to him who by the power at work within us is able to accomplish abundantly far more than all we can ask or imagine, to him be glory in the church and in Christ Jesus to all generations, forever and ever. 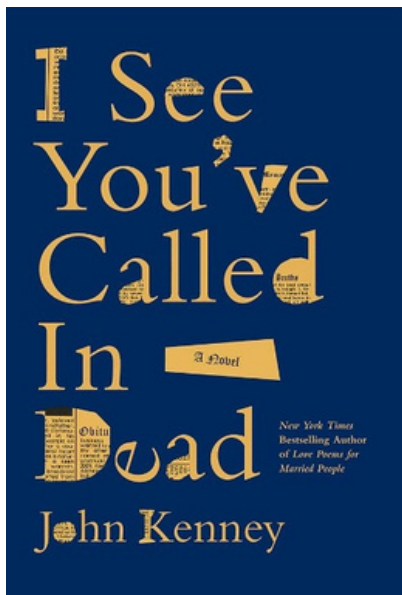

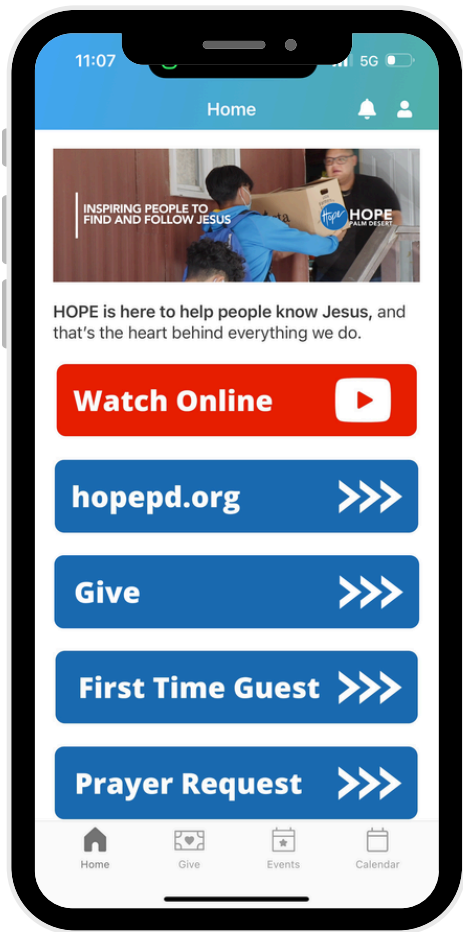



***One on One confidential relationships** for people who need someone to “come along side” during a personal or family crisis

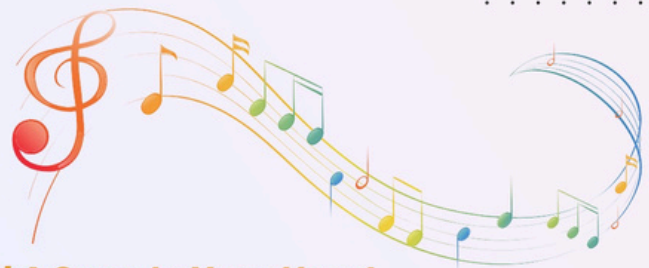
***Prayer** – offered after Hope's services

Women of Hope Summer Studies
"I am worthy," by the Rev. Sara Olson Smith
Saturday, June 13th, July 11th, August 8th

This summer, Women of the ELCA participants will gather in Des Moines, Iowa, under the theme "I am worthy." When Nobel Peace Prize winner Leymah Gbowee spoke in 2017, she invited WELCA participants to reclaim space for women and girls to lead and love in bold ways. This three-part Bible study will help us to define who we are, what we can be, and what we do in the world, in light of our God-given giftedness, identities and relationships.

June: "I am created in God's image. No matter what anyone else says."

We'll begin with the story of God's creation and the "very goodness" that is spoken over every human being. The study will then turn to various scripture texts that have been used to undermine, silence and degrade women for centuries. Unpacking the ways these verses have been read against women shines a light on the realities of sexism and the ways that, for too long, the Bible has been used to prop up the oppression of women. But we will also hear how those same scriptures can be read as invitations to new freedom, community and vocation for people, regardless of gender, for all people were made in God's image.

July: "I am more than one thing: Honoring our many identities."

In her TED talk, "The Danger of a Single Story," Chimamanda Ngozi Adichie names this truth: We are much more than one thing. All of us have intersecting identities, roles and responsibilities. Beyond our ethnicity, the color of our skin or our birthplace, we may also be a sister, a mother, a daughter, a friend. We have various vocations, hobbies and joys.

In this session, we'll explore how the multiple identities of several women in Scripture shape their faithful living. Esther is not just a queen, but a niece, as well as part of an oppressed community of faith. Ruth is so much more than just a widow. Mary Magdalene has more identities than can fit within the allowed word count of this paragraph. So do you!

August: "I am because you are: We need one another."

Our individual identities are always bound up in community. Jesus describes this vision using a vine and branches. Paul talks about a body with many parts. The prophets describe communities of liberative interdependence.

Archbishop Desmond Tutu describes this way of mutual interconnectedness as "Ubuntu," where "my humanity is caught up and bound up inextricably with yours. I can only be fully me if you are fully you."

In delving into Scripture, we learn how no one can flourish unless everyone does, and how our lives are bound up with one another and the planet.
