# Happy Easter

## COFFEE WITH PASTOR GERALD

If you've ever hosted a big gathering, you know the moment. The food is ready. The coffee is brewed. The wine is decanted. The table is set. People are on their way. And there's that brief pause just before everything begins. The house is quiet, almost too quiet, like it's holding its breath.

That's a little bit what this first week of April feels like. We've journeyed through Lent, making our way along the Stations of the Cross. We've slowed down, even just a bit, and taken a moment for some honest self-reflection. Now, as we begin a new month, we're moving toward the weight of Maundy Thursday and the heartache of Good Friday...if we'll let ourselves linger there even for a moment and not jump to the end of the story.

But then: Easter!

Easter...not simply a nice ending to the story, but God's announcement that death doesn't get the final word. The tomb is empty. And that changes everything!

But here's what I've been thinking about. Easter isn't just a day we celebrate. It's a reality we're invited to live. Because most of life doesn't feel like Easter morning. Most of life feels like Monday or Tuesday or some random Wednesday afternoon when nothing dramatic is happening and yet everything still matters.

April gives us a chance to live there. To carry resurrection into ordinary moments. Into our conversations and decisions. Into the way we see ourselves and the way we see others. Because the same power that raised Jesus from the dead is not just something we remember, it's something we're invited to trust, right here, right now.

So this month, slow down for a moment. Pour a cup of coffee or just pause long enough to notice. Pay attention to where you see life showing up. Unexpected hope. Quiet strength. A relationship beginning to heal. A moment of peace you didn't see coming. Those aren't small things. That's resurrection, still at work in your life.



Mikey makes everything a joke, even the clinical depression he's struggled with for years. After a run of failed jobs, he becomes the unlikely basketball coach at a high school for high-risk offenders who are experiencing mental illness. The position becomes suddenly available after the team tried to strangle their last coach.

Every instinct tells Mikey to get as far away from this school as possible. Coaching these kids, who have been arrested for who-knows-what, would be difficult for a normie. For Mikey, it could cause another breakdown and force him right back to living on the street. But he knows that if he has any chance to make his twenty-sixth birthday, he needs to keep this job, even if the school board wants him fired, and the students would rather fight each other than play ball.

This poignant, hilarious, and sometimes uncomfortable novel proves that even the most damaged of us can emerge victorious.







# STEPHEN MINISTRY




Hope's Stephen Ministry team serves the community with:





## “I AM: God’s holy name and promise,” a three-part Bible study by the Rev. Hannah Hawkinson

**Monday Night Study meets April 20th, May 25th from 6:30pm to 8:00pm in Room 6 in the Hope Center.**

**Esther Circle meets every 2nd Wednesday of the month from 9:30am to 11:00am in Room 4 in the Hope Center.**

### **(April) Session two—Gate and shepherd: Guiding and protecting us (John 10)**

Session two builds on the theme of God’s abiding love as we explore another dimension of I AM, God’s holy name and promise: God’s guidance and protection. Guidance and protection are the major themes of the famous “Good Shepherd” discourse in John 10, in which Jesus declares that he is both the good shepherd and the gate for the sheep. Our God who abides with us is also a God who moves with us—who knows us, protects us and leads us through the ups and downs of life.

### **(May) Session three: Resurrection and life: Leading us into abundant life (John 11 and 14)**

This final session revolves around the third dimension of I AM: God’s promise to lead God’s people into abundant life. From before creation to the time of Moses to today, this is God’s enduring promise to God’s people. In declaring that he is “the resurrection and the life,” and “the way, the truth, and the life,” Jesus is stepping into this grand tradition, reminding God’s people to cling to God’s promise, God’s very holy name: I AM. God has promised to be with God’s people—to abide with us, to guide us, to protect us, and to lead us into abundant life, now and forever.
